Overview

This is a concentrated but relaxed course where individuals will be given 'Hints and Tips' on photographing wildlife. Although you will be expected to bring your own camera, if you have one, there will be an opportunity to use long lenses on DSLR cameras while photographing the wildlife available to us.

Content

Although the list below outlines the areas we will cover it is by no means exhaustive and attendees are encouraged to try new techniques and procedures.

- Equipment - what you will need to start or further your photography
- The different types of wildlife photography.
- Taking care of your camera - cleaning lenses and sensors.
- Holding your camera – support techniques and Tripods.
- Focusing – how to get the best from your camera.
- Exposure – how to get the best from your photographs
- Creative techniques - depth of field and composition.
- RAW v JPEG.
- Knowing your subject.
- Getting close to wildlife
- Respecting wildlife – how the law affects photographers
- Further recommendations.

What is included?

The use of cameras and lenses we have available.

Follow up notes issued by e-mail that are tailored to your needs.
